EDUCATE, EQUIP, & EMPOWER

Realife Church has partnered with Priority One for the last 4 years. In 2019, we helped build a Bible College in Burkina Faso. Priority One is passionate about investing in the lives of future leaders. They work closely with Bible colleges, schools, and leadership development organizations around the world to provide the resources they need to educate, equip, and empower the next generation of church leaders.

By serving future leaders they impact the lives of everyone they touch forever. They are dedicated to Christian leadership development through the building of Bible training centers around the world. Priority One is supported by individuals and churches who are passionate about investing in the lives of influencers. Together we have helped build classrooms, dormitories, and libraries in over 50 countries.



PROJECT RESCUE

WE EXIST TO RESCUE AND RESTORE VICTIMS OF SEXUAL SLAVERY

Our ministry began in 1997 when K.K. Devaraj and team members from Bombay Teen Challenge went to Falkland Road in the red-light district of Mumbai, India, with a passion to reach a young generation ensnared by drugs, gangs, and prostitution.

Their team was stunned to find an estimated 100,000 women and children living in slavery... many of whom had been sold by their impoverished families from North India and Nepal.

In this first encounter, over 100 women were challenged to new life in Jesus Christ. However because they were in slavery they could not leave, but instead they asked K.K. Devaraj to take 37 of their little daughters to a place of safety in order to prevent them from a life of prostitution. Out of that night Project Rescue and Bombay Teen Challenge created a safe aftercare home. The shelter became a secure environment where meals were shared, homework completed, clean beds provided, but most importantly the children were introduced to a heavenly Father who loves them and has good purposes for them.

In 2019, Project Rescue ministered to over 37,000 women and children impacted by sexual slavery. In India, Nepal, Bangladesh, Moldova, Tajikistan, Spain and France. Project Rescue partners work to bring the love of Jesus Christ to prostituted women and children at risk.

Over the past 20 years Project Rescue has seen God miraculously work on behalf of women and children in the darkness of sexual slavery. The strongest ministry staff today are former madams and young women who themselves found freedom up to 20 years ago through the ministry.

Last summer, we had the unprecedented opportunity to rescue women and children from the brothels of India. Covid-19 forced the brothels to shut down and traffickers let their victims go freely. We were able to get them into safe housing, provide food, and an education to help them towards independence. Overall, we were able to rescue 100 women from the brothels.



Speed the Light

Realife Students give to provide essential transportation and creative communication equipment, like boats, cars, and even yaks, for missionary evangelism.



One Child Matters

One Child Matters is an international child development ministry helping to meet the physical and spiritual needs of children living in poverty. Through development programs, children receive food, education, medical aid, and hope in Jesus. Realife Church focuses our efforts on one center in the Dominican Republic.



Boys & Girls Missions Challenge

BGMC is a missions program for kids that instills a heart of compassion to reach the lost by meeting critical needs around the world such as feeding programs, water wells, Bible schools, and curriculum.



MISSIONARY SUPPORT

- He has completely restore one marriage
- He has moved in the hearts of four people to rededicate their lives to faithfully follow Him
- He called seven people out of darkness and into His glorious light by saving them!

He has already shown Himself as faithful to bless what He has called us to do and believe this is just the beginning!

All of this, as great as it is, could not have been done without you! God has called all of us to accomplish His work of saving and discipling His lost sheep. The Mobile Pantry Program removes barriers that prevent access to underserved areas. Designed as a food pantry on wheels, the Mobile Pantry works to fulfill the needs of families and individuals that fall outside the reach of other agencies in the area. A truckload of food is distributed to clients through a farmer's market-style distribution where clients choose to take what they need. A typical Mobile Pantry distribution provides enough food for 150 to 300 households.

THE FUTURE OF REALIFE

Our Story

When Realife Church launched in 2007, we met at Greenfield Central High School. Every week we unloaded a box truck, setup and tore down church. However, in Fall of 2007 another local church, First Assembly, voted to close their church and in the process to gift their property to Realife. As a nine month old startup church, we borrowed \$250,000 to remodel our current property at 971 W. US Highway 40. We moved in to this gift from God in May 2008.

Over the next few years we paid cash to pave the parking lot, remodel the offices, expand the kids check-in space, and add nursery rooms. In 2011 we added a second Sunday morning service, and by 2013 we were running 300 in attendance. It took us 3 more years to break the 400 barrier, and by 2016 we knew we needed to find a new place to call home. Adding onto our current facility was not an option, and so we began looking for a new location.

On December 31, 2020 we purchased the former Hancock Wellness Center located at 5151 US Highway 40 near 500 West as well as the 4 acres south. This 84,000 sq ft building will become the new home of Realife Church! We will be remodeling the 43,000 sq ft front building for our church space. It will include a 700 seat auditorium, 11 children's classrooms, adult classroom space and church offices. We will be adding 175 additional parking spaces south of the building. The total cost of the project is \$7.5 million.

In addition to the new church space, we have 40,000 sq ft of gymnasium space that will become the Realife Sports Complex. With three basketball courts, 2 racquetball courts, and a wrestling room, this space will become a premier location for local sports teams to practice and host tournaments. We believe this will be a great outreach opportunity for our community as well as a significant revenue stream for the church.

Our goal is to raise \$500,000 to complete and furnish the new building.

Project 42

Ministry School Scholarships

By offering scholarships to Bible college and Ministry School students, we are positioning them to get the education necessary to be successful in the future. We believe that Realife Church can be a training ground for students who want to pursue a formal education in ministry.

Event Scholarships

Event scholarships enable students & kids to attend our Summer Camps & other events who may not otherwise have the opportunity to attend. Summer camp is an opportunity for kids to meet new friends, experience fun, to have their hearts impacted for Christ in a focused and supervised Christian environment.

ASHLYN SANFORD STORY

In 2019, I went on a life-changing missions trip with Realife Church to Africa. Each day was a new adventure. We first traveled to Zanzibar, Tanzania where we were able to learn about their Islamic culture, take a tour of the former slave market, and even try local cuisine. We were able to visit the English Center and interact with the students. From there, we were able to experience the culture of Nairobi, Kenya. Our most memorable day was visiting the very poor neighborhood of Eastleigh. In this area, made up mostly of Somali refugees, we visited their English center. The students were so excited to see Americans, and I really enjoyed talking with them. We capped off the day eating camel with our hands like locals! We ended our trip with an African safari that was one of the most amazing experiences of my life.

This trip was very powerful for me and completely changed my perspective. I knew that I was lucky to live in the United States, but I had no idea how much so. The poverty there broke my heart. It was even more saddening to see how little choice they have to practice the religion of their choice.



Islam is a harsh religion that lacks the grace and hope of Jesus. In these areas, children are raised Muslim and given no choice. To become a Christian would mean being disowned by their family or possibly even killed. There are times when I have felt being a Christian is difficult here because of something as small as worrying about what others think about me. This trip showed me how very lucky I am.

I would encourage anyone that has a chance to go on a missions trip. It is the kind of experience that truly can't be described in words. It must be experienced. I went on this trip hoping for an adventure and the chance to help others. I left realizing that I may have been the one the most changed. I can't wait to go on another trip in the future.
