Religious Demographic

The religious demographic of Mozambique is traditionally Muslim. Moz is a capital city, so it has a higher population of Christians than other areas. The missionaries are there on missionary visas and do not have to fear persecution for sharing the Gospel freely.

What will we eat?

Food is art, and art is expensive. Mozambique is an underprivileged area so the food is bland. It consists of rice, beans, veggies, fish, garlic and salt.

What is the weather like?

November in Mozambique is hot and humid. Temperature ranges from 90-80°F. There is abundant sunshine but also the risk of a few thunderstorms.

How much does the trip cost?

- **On-Field cost:** \$1400
- **Flights:** \$2000
- **Admin Fee:** \$100

*The cost of your trip includes coverage for everything while in country. This includes but is not limited to, lodging, meals, insurance, transportation and a rest and relaxation day.

Payment Plan

- **Deposit Payment: \$500 due May 1**
- Second payment: \$500 due June 1
- Third payment: \$500 due July 1
- Fourth Payment: \$1000 due August 1
 - This payment amount is subject to change based on flight cost
- Fifth payment: \$500 due September 1
- Final payment: \$500 due October 1
